

# CODE OF CONDUCT

## FOR HOME & SCHOOL ASSOCIATION EVENTS

The St. Robert Home & School Association, in providing social, fundraising, enrichment, and service opportunities for both students and parents, must have a set of guidelines regarding the expectations and responsibilities of all participants. Our goal is to provide an atmosphere that is representative of our Christian faith and is positive, safe, and enriching for all participants. This code supports and is consistent with the *Code of Conduct* established by St. Robert School.

### **Student Responsibilities**

- **Be respectful.**
  - Behave in a Christian manner.
  - Use courteous language.
  - Follow rules and directions.
  - Respect others.
  - Respect school property.
- **Be responsible.**
  - Make good choices.
  - Take responsibility for your words and actions.
  - Be honest.
  - Be a leader and help others make good choices.
- **Be safe.**
  - Remain in designated area for the event.
  - Make sure you have parent permission for your activities.

### **Parent/Guardian Responsibilities**

When an event description or notice specifies that children must be accompanied by parent or guardian, they shall have the following responsibilities:

- Supervise children under your care at all times.
- Ensure children behave in a manner that is respectful, responsible, and appropriate for the event.
- Share responsibility with other adults present for the safe and appropriate behavior of all our children.
- Engage other adults in addressing behavior issues when necessary.
- Notify an event volunteer if you notice or attempt to correct potentially dangerous behavior.
- In case of injury, notify an event volunteer.
- Drink responsibly when alcohol is served.

### **Misconduct**

Event volunteers, consistent with the above guidelines, have the responsibility to identify and address misconduct as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense: verbal warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: parent/guardian accompanying the child will be notified
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: child will be asked to leave the event

### **Association Responsibilities**

- To work cooperatively for the good of the St. Robert community.
- To provide constructive, positive, safe, and enriching events for all participants.
- To treat every person with respect and courtesy.
- To operate in a moral and ethical manner.
