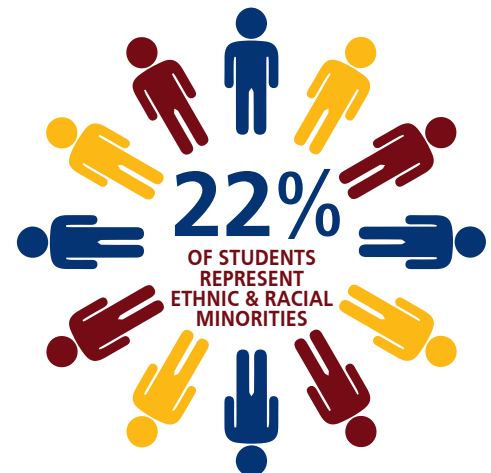
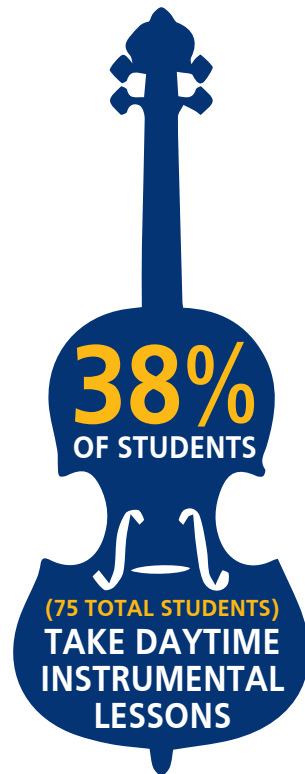

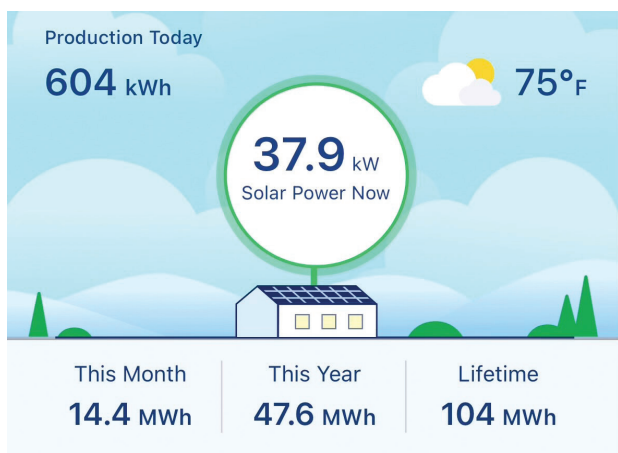


Bike Rack Donation - Thank You, Class of 2023!

Solar Panel Array Donation



St. Robert Catholic School is taking a leap towards sustainability with the installation of a state-of-the-art solar panel array on the school's roof. The solar panel array, funded by Friends of St. Robert, is projected to save the school over \$400,000 in energy costs over their expected life. Project initiation and funding was spearheaded by Kathy and David Wyatt, in memory and honor of their son, Devin, a St. Robert graduate. Solar panels will allow the school to allocate more resources to the educational experience and teacher compensation. St. Robert is proud to be reducing our carbon footprint within our community, and we are so grateful to the Wyatt Family for their commitment to environmental stewardship and St. Robert Catholic School.

Math Curriculum Enhancements

The rich traditions of community and parental involvement at St. Robert School continue to thrive. At the 2023 St. Robert Emerald Auction, the community once again showed its unwavering support, raising a record-breaking \$100,000 through the Paddle Raise. These funds are earmarked to bolster the school's math curriculum for the next decade, ensuring that students receive the best possible education in mathematics. The success of the auction is a testament to the dedication and generosity of the entire St. Robert School community.

Gracias, Señora Demet!

Señora Mary Demet has been inspiring the next generation of **santos y lideres** since she first covered another teacher's maternity leave in 2006. The Demet family's St. Robert story began a generation before with Señora's husband, Don, attending St. Robert. According to Demet, "The fabulous Catholic education" was the first reason their family picked the school for their own six children, and it has been the "support and loving teachers" she works alongside each day that has kept her at St. Robert Catholic School. This year Señora Demet, who is herself a life-long learner, will celebrate her retirement after 22 years in education.



"People before things" isn't just a motto in Señora Demet's classroom: it's infused into her instruction and her daily interactions with students and colleagues alike. Señora explains that beyond exposure to another language, students learn about themselves through learning about others' cultures and ways of living. Middle school students in particular benefit immensely from the human interaction that occurs, and the vulnerability that comes from learning a new language. In the words of Señora Demet, "we all need human interaction... it develops the brain, it opens your mind to other cultures, and other ways of seeing things." Students are more fully immersed in this process by attending a weekend of Spanish immersion at the Concordia Language Villages in Bemidji, Minnesota.

When asked what Señora Demet will miss most about her days at St. Robert, Señora shared with a pause and a few happy tears, "When you walk into our building on a rainy day, I am always greeted with a proud child saying 'Hola! Como estas?' There's such positive energy all throughout our school." We are so grateful to Señora for sharing her talents with our students and wish her **mucho amor** in her next phase of life! **Vaya con Dios**, Señora Demet!

A Fleet To Thrive: Early intervention helps students reach their full potential

As any parent with multiple children will tell you: each child has their unique gifts and struggles. So, too, will the fleet of teachers who lovingly occupy the Learning Resource Center at St. Robert School. Here you will find a small army of palpably passionate lifetime educators whose mission is simple -though not easy: helping children reach their full potentials.

"We ask ourselves, 'What does the child need *now* to be successful?'" asks Mrs. Anne Nehls, a trained Dyslexia Specialist with over 25 years of teaching experience. The answer often looks like a myriad of collaborative efforts between classroom teachers, one-on-one support and parent feedback. While teachers are using evidence-based support systems and interventions, they work with families to help them develop a plan for their student. Their early intervention allows students to get what they need, sooner, which matters according to research. In short, students continue to view themselves as the teachers of St. Robert School see them: beautifully-made and perfectly-abled, while getting the support they need to thrive.

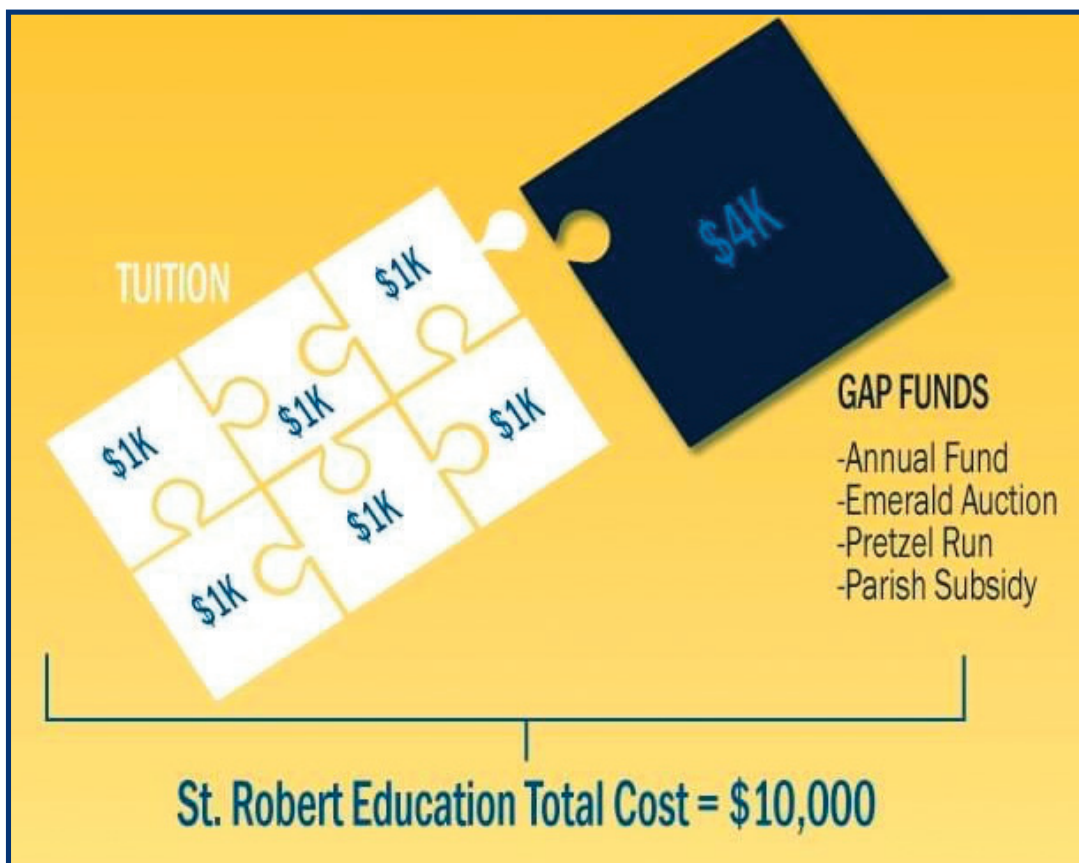
