Emphasis on Catholic Faith & Values

- Catholic teachings and traditions are woven into the curriculum, creating an environment that fosters goodness and kindness.
- Students participate in a variety of experiences to grow in their faith including Mass, prayer, retreats and community service.



Academic Rigor & Personalized Instruction

- Our proprietary curriculum of Standards-Based Learning and Grading promotes higher-order critical thinking across all grades.
- Our teachers promote a deep love of learning.
- Personalized instruction allows teachers to support all types of learners in the same classroom.
- The average class size is 17 students.
- Significant recent investment made in math program.
- Students are empowered to ask questions and defend their thinking in sophisticated ways.
- Students learn important life skills like effective collaboration and using the power of inquiry to dig deeper into a topic.
- We provide a learning environment with minimal external distractions: personal cell phones and non-academic internet use are not permitted at school.
- Technology is integrated into the curriculum in developmentally appropriate ways. Students in grades 2-8 are 1-to-1 with Chromebooks. Devices are carefully monitored to protect and direct student learning.
- St. Robert students successfully transition to high school and beyond.



Strong Music, Language & Extracurricular Programs

- St. Robert has an exceptional music program, offering band, choir, strings, and piano with art and music classes, concerts, and a professionally produced middle school musical.
- 38% of students take daytime instrumental lessons.
- Spanish language instruction in grades 1-8.
- Students have access to several extracurriculars such as Chess Club, Lego League, the School Newspaper, Yearbook, Battle of the Books, and Forensics.
- St. Robert is the 5X Forensics State Champion.
- Volleyball and basketball are offered for grades 5-8 with the "Junior Bobcats" sports program for grades 1-4.
- Leadership program (Student Council) for grades 5-8.

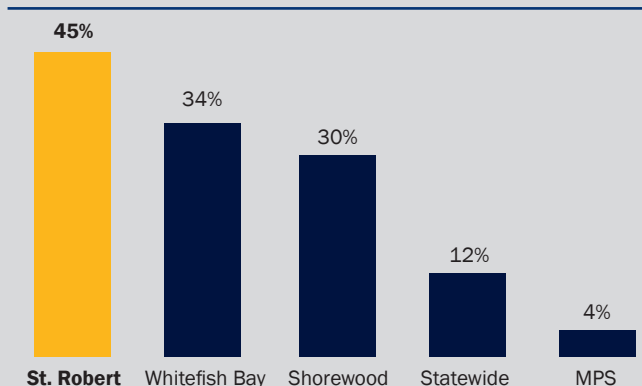


Engaged & Inclusive Community
